### **Driving directions to The Knowlton House**

*From Concord via I-89 Northbound*, take Exit # 12 and go left at end of ramp onto NH Route 11 South. Stay on 11 for 5± miles to Sunapee. Just after gas station (and small library) on left, make left onto Upper Main St. Go ¼ mile up hill, LSPA sign and "The Knowlton House" sign on left side just before lake. There is parking in back of the building.

*From Hanover via I-89 Southbound*, take Exit # 12A. Go right at end of ramp onto Springfield Rd.. Go ½ mile to NH Route 11 and stay right onto Route 11 for 3.45± miles to Sunapee. Just after gas station (and small library) on left, make left onto Upper Main St. Go ¼ mile up hill, LSPA sign and "The Knowlton House" sign on left side just before lake. There is parking in back of the building.

*From Keene, via NH Route 10 North*, go toward Newport (35 ± miles), take NH Route 11 East from Newport to Sunapee (about 5+ miles). Go right onto Main St. immediately after small concrete bridge, just before Exxon station on right. Go ¼ mile up hill, LSPA sign and "The Knowlton House" sign on left side just before lake. There is parking in back of the building.
